### GRANT APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- **Due Date for consideration is May 4, 2012.** The Junior Aid Society Inc. grants 100% of net funds raised annually with grant decisions made by June 30th.
- Only Organizations and Programs that immediately and directly benefit women and children in need in North Shore Communities will be considered.
- Organizations must be designated as a 501 (c)(3) public charity in order to be considered. The Junior Aid Society, Inc. requests that a copy of the government issued 501 (c)(3) tax document be provided along with the completed grant application.
- Gifts are one-time only. Grant requests for operating or capital needs will be accepted, but the requests must be program specific.
- Past grants have ranged from \$500 to \$5000, with the typical grant in the range of \$1,000 to \$3,000 range. The Junior Aid Society, Inc. generally supports 8 to 10 organizations per year.
